

To launch the new university, Purdue will acquire Kaplan University and its institutional operations and assets, including its 15 campuses and learning centers, 32,000 students, 3,000

employees, and decades of experience in distance education.

All existing Kaplan University students and faculty will transition to the new university, which will use the Purdue name in some fashion not yet identified.

The new university will be distinct from others in the Purdue system, relying only on tuition and fundraising to cover operating expenses. No state appropriations will be utilized. It will operate primarily online, but has 15 locations across the United States.
